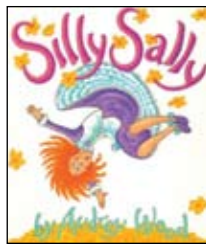
When Mom or Dad asks what you did today, you can tell them ReadRover came to read and play!

By: Keith Baker

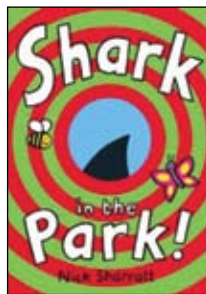
When a tiger suspects he is the beast the jungle animals are fleeing from, he returns to them and points out their similarities.

By: Nick Sharratt

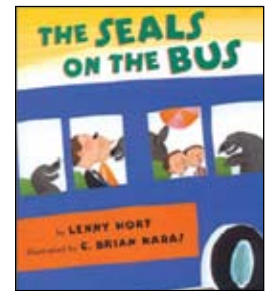
Timothy Pope and his telescope have a wild adventure of mistaken identity.

By: Lenny Hort

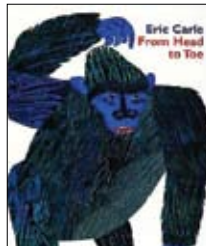
Different animals — including seals, tigers, geese, rabbits, monkeys and more — make their own sounds as they ride all around town on a bus.

By: Eric Carle

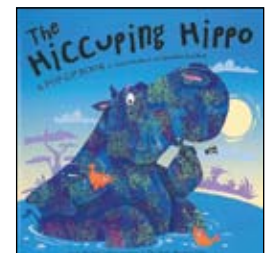
Encourages the reader to exercise by following the movements of various animals; presented in a question and answer format.

By: Steve Webb

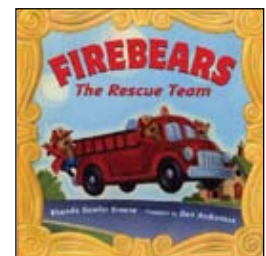
Stamp your feet to the Skunka Tanka beat!

One little monkey...

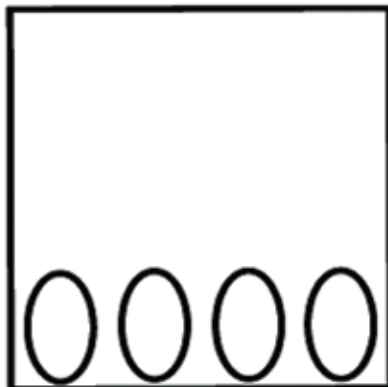
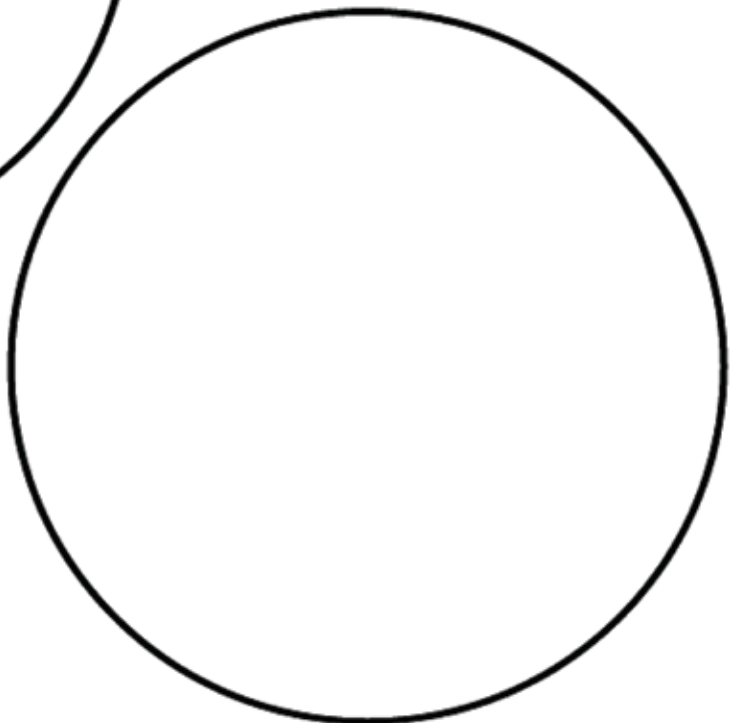
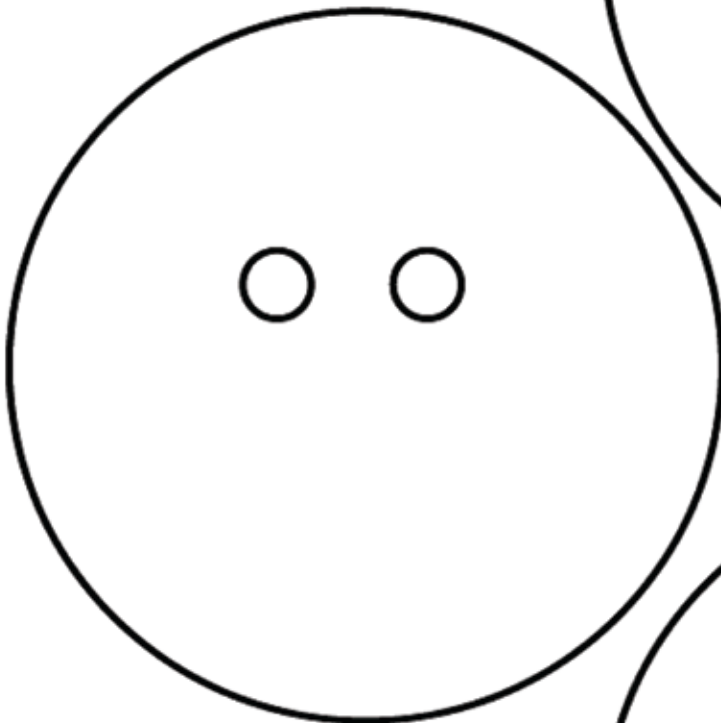
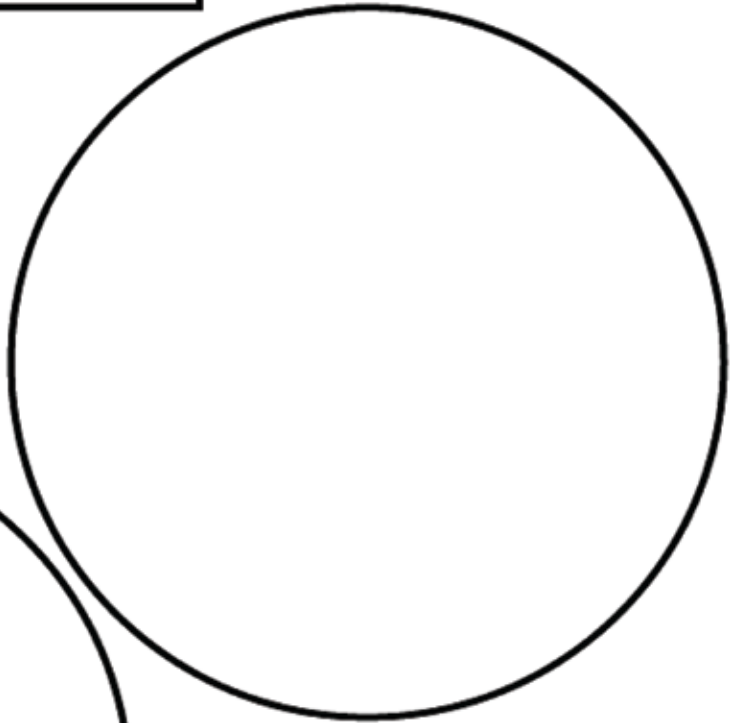
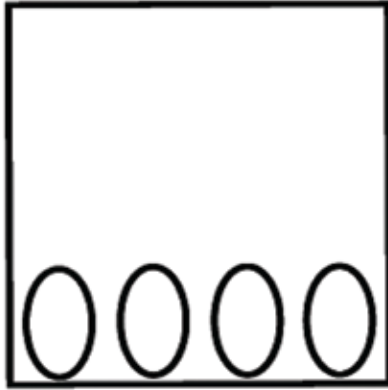
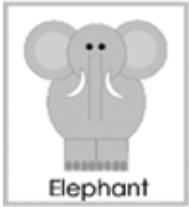
No little monkeys swinging from a tree,

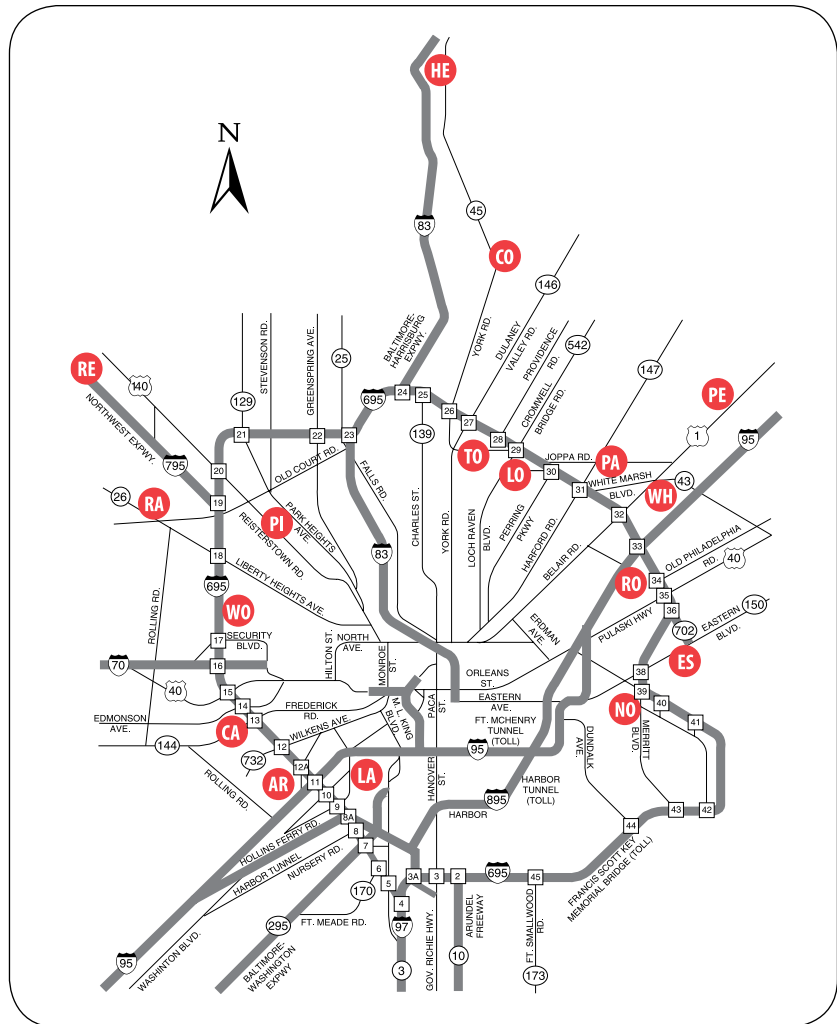
