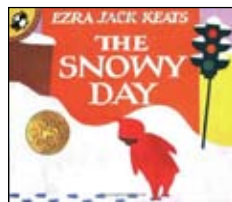

By: Ezra Jack Keats

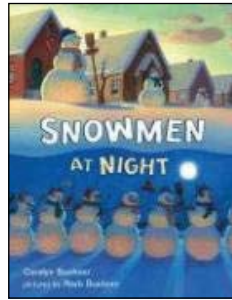
A boy wakes up to discover snow celebrates by making footprints, creating snow angels, knocking snow from a tree and trying to save a snowball for the next day.

By: Caralyn Buehner

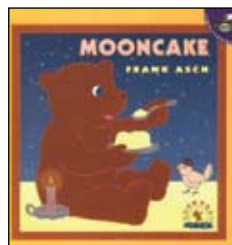
Snowmen play games at night when no one is watching.

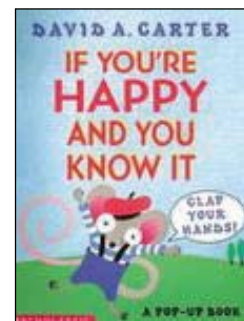
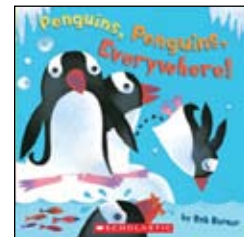
Colorful collage images and whimsical verse make this a funny, bouncy, informative introduction to the world of penguins.

Two little snowmen...

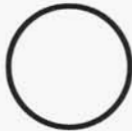

Supplementary Activity

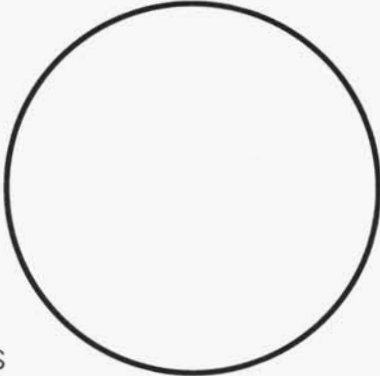
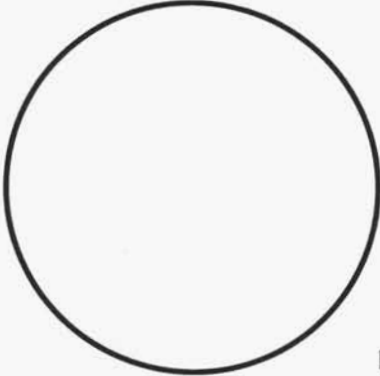
Cut a small, a medium sized and a large circle out of heavy, white paper. Draw a snowpal face on the front of the small circle. Attach pieces of magnetic strip to the backs of the circles. Randomly place the circles on a magnetic surface, such as a non-aluminum baking sheet. Let your child arrange the circles in a snowpal shape.
